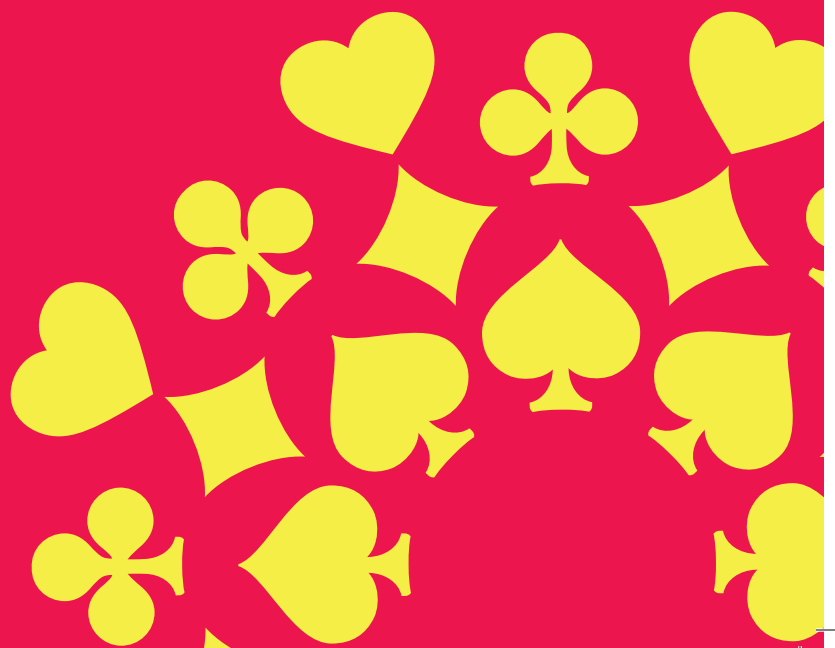
Rules

Invited PENN Play members are eligible to participate in an invite only Blackjack Tournament. If a participant registers but does not report for their session time, the seat may be forfeited or assigned to another guest. Participants may not designate someone to play in their absence. If a guest advances but does not claim their spot, they will forfeit their spot in the tournament, and a wild card will be drawn to fill the vacancy.

How to Play

- Each player will start with 10,000 tournament chips.
- The minimum bet for each hand is \$100 and the maximum bet is "all in".
- Play up to 15 hands for each tournament session.
- At the conclusion of the 15th hand, all chips will be counted and recorded for each player by Table Games Management.
- Table Winners from Round 1 will carry over their chip counts into Round 2.
- Round 2 Chip Adjustment: Table winners from Round 1 entering Round 2 with less than \$10,000 in chips will be adjusted to start Round 2 with \$10,000 in chips.
- Table Winners from Round 2 will carry over their chip counts into Round 3 with no chip adjustments to start Round 3.
- Round 1 can accommodate up to 150 players (up to 5 sessions, each consisting of 6 tables with 5 guests per table). The top chip leaders from each table for Round 1 of the tournament will advance to Round 2. All participants who do not advance from Round 1 will receive a \$50 Free Bet.
- Round 2 can accommodate up to 30 players (consisting of 6 tables with 5 guests per table). If needed up to (5) wild card winners will be drawn to fill the remaining spots in Round 2. The top chip leaders from each table for Round 2 will advance to Round 3, the Final Round of the tournament. All participants who do not advance from Round 2 will receive a \$100 Free Bet.
- In Round 1 and Round 2, ties impacting advancement will be resolved by a three (3) hand playoff.
- Round 3, the Final Round can accommodate up to 6 players (consisting of 1 table with 6 guests; the top chip leaders from each table for Round 2. Chip counts from Round 2 will carry over into the Final Round in accordance with the chip carryover rules outlined above.
- In the Final Round, if there is a tie, the tied participants will split the combined prize amounts.
- For the 15th and final hand in Round 3 of the tournament, all participants must write down their wager on a confidential form before the hand is dealt. These forms will be collected and reviewed by Table Games Management. Players will then be required to place the exact wager indicated on their form for the final hand.
- All guests in Round 3, the Final Round, will receive a prize.
